#### REQUIEREMENTS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE CONFERENCE

The authors and co-authors of papers (participants of the Conference) may be students and young scientists to the age of 35 (including).

#### REQUIREMENTS TO COMPLETE MATERIALS

- the papers submitted to the Conference should not be published earlier or sent for publication to other publishers;
- total amount of materials from 2000 to 3000 characters including space bars;
- all abbreviations (except generally known) should be written in full when first mentioned;
- · theses should not contain tables, diagrams, illustrations.

**Structure of theses:** family names and first names of authors in full; title of the paper; scientific advisor; name of the educational establishment where the work was performed; town/city, country; a brief content of the report (text of theses).

# Papers meeting the requirements will be published in the collected articles of the Conference.

Arrangement fee of **200** hryvnas for the participation in the Conference (publication of theses) should be transferred through the departments of "PrivatBank" to the account of Viktor Romanchuk c\a № 5168757218984930.
