ABOUT AUTUMN SCHOOL

Ukrainian medical education is lacking a platform for exchange of good practices and communication on international standards (e.g. World Federation for Medical Education framework). We therefore have set up the 'Autumn School on Medical Education' to support conceptional development of medical education reform in Ukraine. The aim is to stimulate mutual learning and to facilitate multisectoral networking among medical educators and other healthcare professionals. **The Autumn School provides opportunities for representatives of medical universities to improve quality of education, to foster changes with regard to student oriented approaches, academic integrity and to contribute to a conducive environment for health care reforms.**

The Autumn School on Medical Education is inspired by the success of the Summer School "Health care systems transformation: Eastern Europe", the Winter School "Public Health in Ukraine" and by the Lugano Summer School on Health Policy, Economics and Management in Lugano, Switzerland.

These educational platforms were established with the support of the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (Summer School "Health care systems transformation: Eastern Europe" within Swiss-Ukrainian "Mother and child care" since 2014) and other partners.



The Autumn School on Medical Education aims at sharing a common understanding on recognised international medical education frameworks (for quality improvement) and at supporting medical education reform in Ukraine through launching a multisectoral platform for good practices exchange among decision makers and senior professionals.

MODULES AND FORMAT

The Autumn School offers several formats of participation:

- Participation;
- Participation with poster presentation;
- Participation with oral presentation.



The Autumn School encompasses the following **educational - networking formats**:

- Key-note speaker plenaries for all participants;
- Debates on current priority topics on medical education in Ukraine;
- Parallel sections with workshops from leading specialists in respective fields;
- Inspirational speeches of educators, medical doctors, students, and rectors;
- Conference sessions, so participants can share their achievements (educational, research).

Speakers of the event are leading professors, experts and professionals from Ukrainian and European institutions, international organizations. The speakers share their knowledge, opinion and experience in medical education and health care for professional development, change and training education – related skills.

Working languages are English and Ukrainian. Simultaneous translation is provided.

Educational activities are scheduled from 9:00 to 19:00 each day during 7 – 9 October 2019.

Participants are expected to read provided by the speakers and organizers provided materials before the School starts.

PARTICIPANTS OF AUTUMN SCHOOL

Primarily, we invite to apply those professionals who are open for fresh perspectives on medical education, who are ready to eye opening ideas and their implementation, who wish to gain knowledge and skills in the area of medical education and who already have experience in making changes for better in medical education (in Ukraine).

In particular, the following groups are invited to the Autumn School:

- **Educators** from “Medical education development” project pilot universities and nursing schools are the primary groups since the further project activities are based on the “introductory” workshops;
- **Medical educators** representing non-pilot institutions;
- **Administrators** of medical educational institutions: rectors / deputy rectors, representatives from educational departments, heads of the family medicine departments;
- **Policymakers** in the area of medical education;
- **Medical doctors** involved in the Internatura mentorship;
- **Medical doctors** who consider being providers of CME products;
- **Students** of medical universities who have active position in improving quality of medical education and who consider future career of medical educator;
- **Representatives** of civil society who advocate for medical education quality assurance and primary health care solutions, policies and innovations.

HOW TO APPLY

Applicants are welcome to submit their applications from **May 7 until June 7, 2019**.

THE APPLICATION FORM INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING PARTS:

1. **Education** and work experience of the applicant;
2. **Professional achievements** and further aims;
3. **Motivation statement** for participation in the Autumn School 2019;
4. **Submission of the abstract** and information about the co-authors in case the participant selects “participation with presentation” format. The Organizational Committee will select applications most relevant to the Autumn School objectives abstracts. It means that participants will present their research or experience at the Conference session within the Autumn School;
5. **Questionnaire** the information gathered is important for the organizers to tune the content of the School closer to the needs of participants. It will not be used for the selection process.

The Organizers will assess only full applications submitted before the deadline. We will inform applicants whether they are selected for scholarship or not **until July 15, 2019**. Up to 90 outstanding and motivated participants will be selected.

FEES AND EXPENSES

Based on the assessment, the most outstanding applicants receive a **full scholarship** for participation provided by the Ukrainian – Swiss project “Medical education development” within.

The standard participation fee is 700 Swiss francs (or 18 000 UAH in 2019). The fee covers tuition, educational materials, translation,

accommodation, coffee-breaks and lunches. Please, note that scholarships do not cover travel expenditures, dinners and per diems. Those who applied to the Autumn School and who are not selected for the scholarship based participation, could participate on the paid-based mode upon the approval of the Organizational Committee.
