DEAR COLLEAGUES AND STUDENTS!

You are invited to participate in the IIIrd International Olympiad for Medical Students "Samarkand-2020" to be held on 16-17 December 2022.

The purpose of the "Samarkand-2020" Olympiad is to popularise knowledge in various fields of medicine and basic sciences, as well as to increase students' interest in learning and science, and to create opportunities for them to demonstrate their scientific and creative potential.

Olympiad tasks are to:

- 1. Identify and detect gifted students and contribute to their developmente;
- 2. Improve students' knowledge of medical disciplines;
- 3. Develop students' skills and competencies in practical medicine;
- 4. Develop the ability of students to use the knowledge, skills and abilities they acquired in analysing clinical cases;
- 5. Familiarise medical students with the heritage of global and national medicine for the benefit of the folk.

Languages of the Olympiad: Uzbek, Russian and English.



RULES FOR PARTICIPATION

Medical students are invited to participate in the Olympiad, according to their field of education and year of study.

One participant can choose only one academic discipline. Only 10 students from each university can participate in 10 different subjects.

The Olympiad will consist of 3 competitions:

- 1. Welcome speech of the HEI team (video clip);
- 2. Contest of scientific projects of young scientists;
- 3. Competition in 34 disciplines.
 The Olympiad is held in offline/online format.

1. «Welcome speech of the team»

In the video, the team introduces their university and city.

Time limit: 5 minutes. The video in .mp4 or .wmv format should be sent to <u>videosamarkand.2020@gmail.com</u> by 1 December 2022 (file name: Team greeting - university name).

The number of participating universities is unlimited: 1 video from each university.

Form of participation: online.

2. «Contest of scientific projects of young scientists»

Form of participation in the competition: presentation of the results of their research work in person.

Papers must be prepared in MS PowerPoint application and sent by 1 December 2022 to naukasamarkand.2020@gmail.com (file name: "Research project - participant's name").

Time limit: up to 5 minutes.

The number of participants is limited: 1 participant from each university. Form of participation: offline

3. Competition in 34 disciplines

Requirements for online participation

I - stage

- Testing (time: 13:00 to 13:30).

Number of questions: 30 Running time: 30 minutes

A student with less than 50 points (maximum 100 points) will not advance to the next round.

II - stage

- Oral questioning (time: 14:00 to 17:00). TIBBLYOT UNIVERSITETI

Maximum score: 100 points

- 1. Discipline question (1 question), maximum score: 25 points;
- 2. Case solving (1 problem), max. score: 25 points;
- 3. Evaluation of practical skills (1 practical skill), maximum number of points: 50 points

The sum of round I and round II is the result of the scores

Maximum score: 200 points. Participants of this type of Olympiad (online) will receive separate honours and certificates for participation.

The number of participants is not limited. In this category there is no team scoring, only individual participation.

Requirements for offline participation

I - stage

- Testing (time: 13:00 to 14:00).

Number of questions: 30 Running time: 30 minutes

II - stage

- Oral questioning (time: 14:00 to 17:00).

Maximum score: 100 points and paylar

1. Discipline question (1 question), maximum number of points: 25 points;

2. Case solving (1 problem), maximum: 25 points;

Evaluation of practical skills (1 practical skill), maximum number of points: 50 points.

The sum of round I and round II is the result of the scores

Maximum score: 200 points. The number of participants is limited:

10 participants are regulated from each HEI and each participant can only participate in one subject and only in offline format. Participants of this type of Olympiad (offline) will receive individual places of honour and certificates for participation.

In this category there will be team scoring (winners and runners-up will be determined by the total number of points obtained).

Summing up the results.

The answers of the participants will be evaluated by a team of an international jury. The winners and runners-up of the Olympiad will be determined by the total number of points scored.

The winners of the Olympiad will be awarded diplomas and the participants will be awarded certificates of the Olympiad.

Awarding ceremony will take place at the closing ceremony of the III International Olympiad "Samarkand-2020" on December 17 at 14:00.


